Welcome to our league!

Ladies of any skill level and age are welcome to join our league. We accept members all season long. Ladies have the choice of playing 9 or 18 holes on Tuesdays.

To Join:

All returning and new members must fill out a league application and pay a one time membership fee of \$40.00/player for the 2023 season. All applications must be turned in to the golf shop at Glenmoor. League dues can be paid in-person (preferred) or over the phone at (801) 280-1742 ext. 1, 3, or 6.

At Glenmoor, we require a GHIN Account (handicap) to participate in the league. If you absolutely do not want to set up a GHIN account, you can still play league rounds. However, you will be entered as a zero handicap for our net division. Having a golf handicap number benefits you! For example, if you score an 82 for 18 holes, and have a 12 handicap, your gross score is 82 and your net score is 70.

League Play

Ladies in the league are welcome to play any time on Tuesdays. You have the choice of playing 9 or 18 holes each week. Feel free to switch week to week! For 9 hole rounds, league will almost always be played on the front nine unless otherwise noted.

For tee times, please refer to our tee time spreadsheet that will show pre-blocked times for ladies league players. Our course allows public tee times to be booked up to 5 days in advance. Times will be blocked for ladies up to 7 days in advance. Please type your name into an available tee time. Only 4 players maximum are allowed per tee time. Single players are not allowed for league play; you must play with another league player so your score can be verified by them. For times outside the pre-blocked times, please call the golf shop and reserve a tee time for however many players you wish to have in your group. If a time is made over the phone with the golf shop, please email Sirene at sirene@golfglenmoor.com with the added time so she can update the spreadsheet.

League format and the game for payouts will change week to week. You can find the format and game details on your scorecard when you check-in for your round on league day.

Unless otherwise noted, your league round scores will be posted to your GHIN accounts to help update your handicap number.

League Costs

Each week, a league player must pay their \$5.00 game fee, golf course green fee, and cart fee (if you choose to ride for your round).

Personal golf carts: If you own your own golf cart you are welcome to use that for your round as long as the tires on your golf cart are appropriate for the course. Any golf cart with aggressive tire traction is not allowed as it will kill/damage the grass you drive on.

League Rules

We follow the USGA Rules of Golf for all forms of competitive play in our league. There are 24 rules of golf with the USGA, please familiarize yourself with the main rules that you will commonly encounter in your rounds. **Please use the USGA's website and app as a reference for you as you familiarize yourself with the rules.** You are welcome to use the rules app during the round to help you solve any rules questions you may encounter on the course. We want our league to stay welcome to players of all

skill levels. If you see a rule breach, or have rules questions, feel free to let Sirene or Jeremy know. Warnings will be given before any type of consequences. The best way to learn the rules is through actual play, and we wish for experiences on the course to serve as a learning experience for future rounds.

League Payouts

The \$5.00 game fee will go directly to payouts in the form of merchandise credit to the best finishing players each week. For stroke play, we pay out a gross division and net division for both 9 hole and 18 hole rounds.

Merchandise credit can only be spent on merchandise at Glenmoor. Credit cannot be exchanged for cash or golf related services. **All credit earned will expire December 1st, 2023 and will not carry over to next year.**

Results will be scored and payouts distributed before the following week of league play. Results can be viewed via the tee time spreadsheet or on the ladies league webpage: <https://golfglenmoor.com/ladies-league/>

Scorecards: accurate score must be kept on the scorecards. 2 signatures must be present when turning your scorecard into the golf shop after your round. On the player's name row, please keep the total score for each hole. Every time the club makes contact with the golf ball counts as a stroke (shot) and must be counted. We have a double par maximum score in place for each hole (for example, on a par 5 the maximum score will be 10. If the ball is not holed by the 10th stroke, pick up your golf ball, write a 10 on the hole, and move on to the next hole). For every hole, the golf ball must be holed before moving onto the next hole. No gimmes.

Lost scorecards or "No Cards (NC)": accidents happen and human error occurs. If we do not receive your scorecard, we cannot compare your scores to the other players who played that day. We can issue a \$5.00 return to you if your hole by hole scorecard is not available.

Poor weather: league will normally be held regardless of the weather. Unless the golf course closes, league play will be available. We cannot force players to play. Please be understanding if there are last minute drop outs or cancellations from league players.

Closest-to-the-hole Contests will occur every week on Holes 3 & 7. Look for the little silver sign off to the side of the greens. Prizes can be claimed in the Indoor Golf Center. Please email Sirene at sirene@golfglenmoor.com with which prize you claim so our inventory can be tracked. Thank you!
