

Rules: USGA and local rules will be in effect and must be played by all members during Men's Association weekly play (local rules will not be in effect for tournament play).

Association Fee: \$50 per member

Eligibility: Prior to the Club Championship, Glenmoor Golf Club will host 9-hole events weekly on Wednesday & Thursdays, and 18-hole events on a Saturday. The Men's & Sr. Men's Club Championship will be held mid-summer. Each player is required to play in **at least 6** events before qualifying for the Club Championship.

Weekly Fees (9-hole events): \$23.50 walking, \$33.50 riding (REGULAR RATES)

\$18 Glenmoor Club Pass walking, \$25 Glenmoor Club Pass riding (CLUB PASS RATE)

\$8 mandatory game. (\$5 optional **cash** skins game.)

Winnings: Credit to the golf shop will be issued to members who place in each division.

Handicapping: UGA handicap required. All handicaps are updated daily with a soft cap and hard cap set in place by the World Handicap System. No sandbagging! There is a maximum handicap of 26, so if a player's handicap is over 26, they will only get 26 strokes. We pay Net & Gross winners in all weekday events. The world golf handicap system is updated and reviewed after each round played.

LOCAL OUT OF BOUNDS RULE: Model Local Rule E-5

“When a player's ball has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds, the player may proceed as follows rather than proceeding under stroke and distance.

For two penalty strokes, the player may take relief by dropping the original ball or another ball in this relief area (see Rule 14.3):

Two Estimated Reference Points:

- a. Ball Reference Point: The point where the original ball is estimated to have: Come to rest on the course, or Last crossed the edge of the course boundary to go out of bounds.
- b. Fairway Reference Point: The point of fairway of the hole being played that is nearest to the ball reference point, but is not nearer the hole than the ball reference point.

Tees and Times: All Men's League members will play weekly on Wednesdays and Thursdays from the BLUE tees. Seniors will play Wednesdays and Thursdays from the WHITE tees (55+). Players can play anytime of the day as long as they play with another member of the league to verify scores. Must have two signatures on scorecards. Players may book League Tee Times 7 days in advance (10 days with premium club pass) by calling the pro-shop at 801-280-1742 (extension 1 or 3).

March: Men's Opener March 28th ()

**For men's league Saturday tournaments you are not able to request 4-somes. This will give you an opportunity to get to know other people in the league. During Saturday tournaments, we will be following USGA ruling which includes: pairing done by handicap, pace of play policies.

GHIN HANDICAP- We require everyone in the league to have an up-to-date handicap through the UGA. In order to sign up for the men's league you are required to have your GHIN number with you. If you would like to join without a handicap, you are welcome

to; however, you will play as a 0 handicap until you get a GHIN. It is the player's responsibility to notify pro shop workers when you receive your GHIN number. Please make sure that your GHIN has been renewed for the year.

CHEATING- Anyone who has been accused of cheating or writing an incorrect score will play their next men's league round with an employee to verify their score. (Please note: hitting the ball left of the white stakes on Glenmoor's Hole #6 off of their tee shot is out of bounds and the player needs to rehit their tee shot). Make sure that your ball is holed on every hole, if you pick up you receive a 9 for the hole. (**NO GIMMIES!**)
